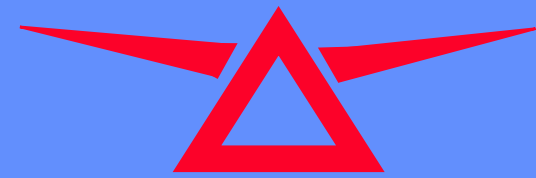


# *Safety Management*

It is each departments responsibility to consider the impact of possible occurrences to the Safety of the Airline.



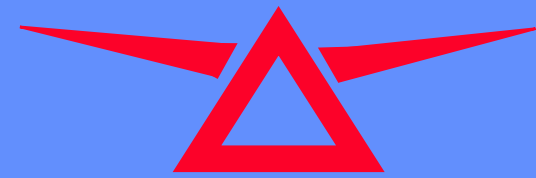

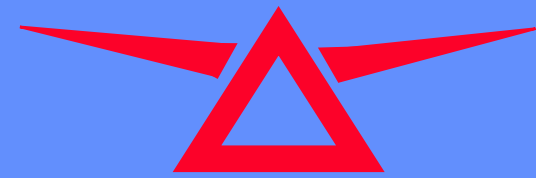
## Positive Safety Culture

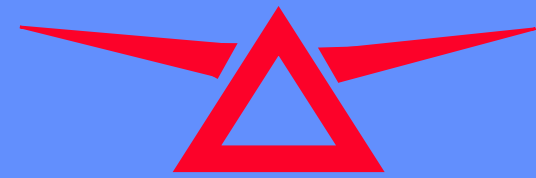


# *Safety Management*

Having carefully defined the procedures it is important to ensure that checks on the integrity of these procedures are undertaken regularly.

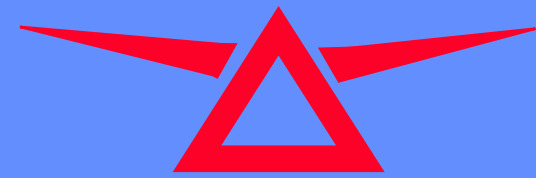
